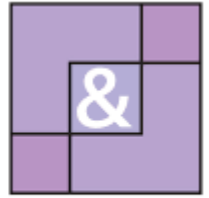

The C&M ambition - creating a culture shift and focus on prevention using MECC

- We want to see MECC flourish in every place, building on great existing local work and new innovative approaches created
- We want MECC to become normal, every day practice and integral to organisational policy and commissioning processes
- Our ambition goes beyond increasing MECC training opportunities to creating a culture shift and focus on prevention

Systems leadership workshop – April 2018

Partners from across C&M met to establish a shared vision and the key elements of a strategic framework to make the ambition a reality.

The partners agreed key recommendations including:

1. Create a consistent and standardised approach to MECC, with an online portal to share resources
2. Establish a culture focused on prevention, this was seen as critical to enable staff to fully utilise MECC training
3. Produce an effective Communication and Engagement Strategy and ensure senior leadership ownership
4. Establish a Partnership Board to oversee the work on behalf of the broader network.
5. Develop robust and standardised evaluation methods

Partnership Board and T&F groups

- MECC Partnership Board have met twice (July and October)
- The Strategic Framework and Terms of Reference ratified by the Partnership Board
- 3 Task and finish groups established to progress training, evaluation and communications & engagement
- **Training** -MECC Face to face training programme developed to provide consistent, high quality training across the sub-region
 - 2 X pilot training sites have been identified for delivery prior to roll out in January.
 - 1 X place (Cheshire West Local Authority 0-19 service)
 - 1 X Trust (Alder Hey Foundation Trust)

Partnership Board and T&F groups

- **Communications and Engagement** -Commissioning a Cheshire & Merseyside approach to develop;
 - An engaging C&M MECC brand
 - An online resource portal for supporting frontline staff
 - A C&M MECC campaign
 - A toolkit to support local communication teams
 - A MECC Pledge
- **Evaluation** - Draft evaluation frameworks include pre and post evaluation of face to face training and an organisational evaluation

Securing additional resources

- DsPH and the SCN co-fund a co-ordinator post
- Halton Health Improvement Team contribution to support MECC training delivery
- A large number of C&M provider trusts have made a commitment to MECC and a small financial contribution
- Successful HEE LWAB bid for £120K

Local Workforce Advisory Board (LWAB) Bid

- The successful bid for £120K will deliver the following key deliverables;
- **Strategic Support**
 - Enlisting senior strategic support for MECC in partner organisations
 - Strengthening strategic links to ensure MECC is embedded in organisational policy and strategy to support sustainability
- **Accredited training and suite of online materials**
 - Provider trust and place based sessions to be rolled out across the sub-region
 - Suite of online resources will support frontline professionals to deliver MECC
- **Comprehensive communications and engagement strategy**
 - Develop an engaging C&M branding to work across the sub-region and work well with existing brands
 - Communications campaign to include development of a shared tool kit, shared on-line resource portal and a MECC pledge for organisations to sign up to
