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Cheshire & Merseyside (C&M) AMR Activities – Update

- Progress update on project to develop an education and training programme on AMR [based on virtual reality (VR) concept] for prescribers in the community, primary and secondary care. We are in the early stages of project development. To support this project and the wider C&M AMR agenda we are delighted to announce the secondment of three medicines management and three GP leads (one each for the three Place Based Care System in C&M).

New National Hand Hygiene and Personal Protective Equipment Policy

NHS England together with NHS Improvement have produced a practice guide for NHS healthcare staff of all disciplines in all care settings that covers how and when to decontaminate hands. This national policy aims to:

- Support a common understanding (making the right thing easy to do for every patient, every time)
- Reduce variation in practice and standardise care processes
- Improve how knowledge and skills are applied in infection prevention and control
- Help reduce the risk of healthcare-associated infection
- Help to align practice, education, monitoring, quality improvement and scrutiny
